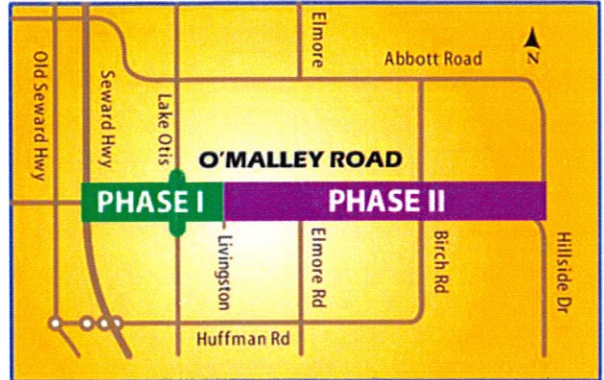
Seward Highway to Livingston Street

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is proposing to reconstruct O'Malley Road from the Seward Highway to Hillside Drive. The purpose of the project is to provide an improved roadway that improves safety, accommodates projected future traffic volumes, and provides a multi-use pathway to enhance pedestrian and non-motorized transportation.

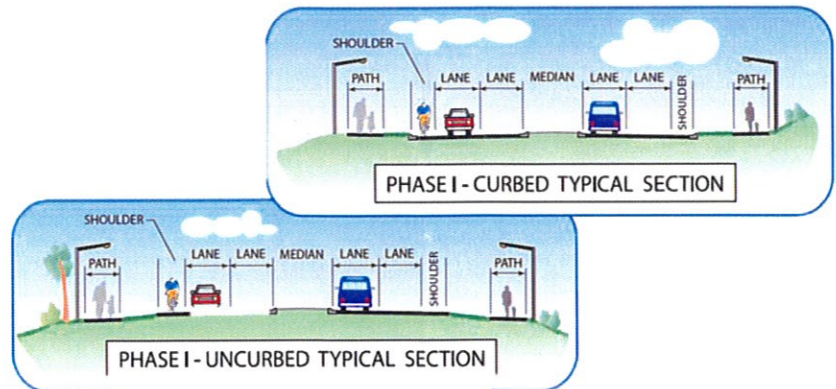
The project is divided into two phases: **Phase I** is from Seward Highway to Livingston Street (approximately 1/3 mile east of Lake Otis Parkway). **Phase II** is from Livingston Street to Hillside Drive. Construction of Phase I is anticipated to begin in 2017. Phase II construction is anticipated to begin in 2019.



PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

Phase I of the O'Malley Road project proposes the following:

- Widen the road to four lanes - two through lanes in each direction
- A 16-foot wide raised median to separate oncoming traffic, with median openings and turning lanes as needed
- A 10-foot wide, separated, paved, multi-use pathway on both the north and south side of O'Malley Road
- Continuous illumination



CURRENT STATUS

Phase I was awarded to QAP and construction is anticipated to begin in late April or early May.
